- 5. Why is English subject given so much importance in ranking although the student meets the eligibility criteria of 55% in english?
- 6. What is the difference between degree and diploma?
- 7. Highlight on the undertaking taking letter (legal) for the scholarship students.
- 8. Why is M. Ed program from taktse is not recognized while the similar programmes offered by Paro College of Education and Samtse College of Education are?
- 9. Why is there an age limit for ex-country scholarship?
- 10. If a student goes to study in a college after finding out that the college is recognized but if half way through study the college is not recognized, then what is the status of the degree?
